Though experience is not necessary to participate, a sincere interest in aviation is a desired trait. With that in mind, the following commitments are expected:

- 1. Work is done each Saturday between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. We expect you to attend each week or **notify us ahead of time when you cannot attend**. Poor attendance and/or lack of notification are reasons to be dropped from the program.
- 2. Parents are welcome to stay during workdays. However, we would expect them to work along with the students.
- 3. Each student is expected to keep track of their time and the specific work that they accomplished each week. This time can be used to as experience for those who are interested in becoming aircraft mechanics.
- 4. Participation in at least one (1) Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Chapter 180 Young Eagles flight experience is available to all students. (This also makes the student eligible for a free Aviation Ground School program made available by Sporty's Pilot Shop. This is a benefit for those students who would like to move forward with getting a Sport Pilot Certificate, but is not mandatory for participation in the Teen Aircraft Factory of Manasota build program).
- 5. Access to the Teen Aircraft Factory mentors is available to all students to answer their aviation questions.
- 6. The building of an aircraft, as well as aviation in general, is serious business. No horseplay will be tolerated while on airport grounds, in the hangar, with the tools and/or work with the project.
- 7. The airport and its premises are a secure area. All movement MUST be escorted by a credentialed work leader.
